A group for young adults who struggle with social understanding

Topics covered will include:

- Shared understanding of words, terms and expressions.
- Different contexts have different expectations
- Different relationships have different expectations
- Asking questions for clarification and support.
- Managing discomfort.
- Self-advocacy and supports
- How much to self-disclose and judging the context.

This group series will address social challenges through shared activities in a small group setting. The meetings are seminar-style (meeting for exchange of ideas). Topics and activities are designed for group discussion and participation.
